Black was convicted of two counts of exposing a child to harmful material in an incident where he sent sexually explicit photos to who he thought was a 14-year-old girl. He was actually conversing with an undercover officer who was posing as a minor female in a chat room.

Black has served the entirety of his sentence and is no longer subject to supervision requirements. He is required to register with the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry. He also will be on lifetime GPS tracking.

The purpose of this notification is to ensure safe neighborhoods by informing the public when a sex offender who qualifies for a Special Bulletin Notification is released into the Beloit community. On June 1, 1997, Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 (Act 440), the Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Law, took effect to enhance public safety and protection.
