## SEX OFFENDER RELEASE - COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

**Dec. 19, 2019** - The Wisconsin Department of Corrections has informed the Beloit Police Department that Michael G. Quade, age 39, will reside at 1861 Sun Valley Drive in Beloit starting Friday, Dec. 20. Michael Quade was released from prison in June, and he has been residing at 1216 Portland Ave., Beloit, WI, which is a temporary living placement location rented by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections.

The purpose of this notification is to ensure safe neighborhoods by informing the public when a sex offender who qualifies for a Special Bulletin Notification is released into the Beloit community. On June 1, 1997, Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 (Act 440), the Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Law, took effect to enhance public safety and protection.

Quade's targeted victims include minor female acquaintances. He was convicted of 2<sup>nd</sup> degree sexual assault of a child in 1998 and in 2008. He also was convicted of tampering with a GPS tracking device in 2014 and sex offender-fail/update information in 2016.

Quade remains on supervision until Feb. 17, 2028, and is required to register with the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry. He also will be on lifetime GPS monitoring.

Conditions of supervision include:

- No unsupervised contact with minors

- No taverns/bars/liquor stores
- No contact with the victim
- Not to consume alcohol or drugs
- Comply with standard sex offender rules
- Cooperate with electronic monitoring
- Face-to-face contact with law enforcement
- Comply with all requirements and lifetime registration of the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry

The Beloit Police Department expects Quade to cooperate and comply with the above conditions and rules. If you observe any violations, please contact the Beloit Police Department at the non-emergency number: 608-757-2244.
