SEX OFFENDER RELEASE - COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Jan. 23, 2020 - The Wisconsin Department of Corrections has notified the Beloit Police Department that Joshua S. Sweat, 37 will be released from prison on Tuesday, Jan. 28, 2020. He will reside at 1216 Portland Ave., Beloit, WI, which is a temporary living placement location rented by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections.

The purpose of this notification is to ensure safe neighborhoods by informing the public when a sex offender who qualifies for a Special Bulletin Notification is released into the Beloit community. On June 1, 1997, Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 (Act 440), the Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Law, took effect to enhance public safety and protection.

Sweat's targeted victims were juvenile females; he sexually assaulted a cognitively delayed juvenile victim who became pregnant. He was convicted of 2nd degree sexual assault of a child in November 2006 and 2nd degree sexual assault of a child in July 2009.

Sweat remains on supervision until Feb. 2, 2032, and is required to register with the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry. He also will be on lifetime GPS monitoring.

Conditions of supervision include:

- No unsupervised contact with minors
- No contact with the victim(s)
- Not to consume drugs
- Comply with standard sex offender rules
- Cooperate with electronic monitoring
- Face-to-face contact with law enforcement
- Comply with all requirements and lifetime registration of the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry

The Beloit Police Department expects Sweat to cooperate and comply with the above conditions and rules. If you observe any violations, please contact the Beloit Police Department at the non-emergency number: 608-757-2244.
