Construction Forecast June 1-5, 2020

Monday June 1 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nightly lane closures on I-39/90 NB and SB between County AB and the US 12/18 (Bellline) Interchange from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Friday. Newville Road under I-39/90 near Edgerton will be CLOSED until early July 2020 as crews pour the new I-39/90 bridge deck. Alternate route required.
Tuesday June 2 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No major I-39/90 construction impacts anticipated.
Wednesday June 3 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No major I-39/90 construction impacts anticipated. I-43 traffic will shift onto the new WIS 81 lanes between I-39/90 and Gateway Blvd. in Beloit. One lane will remain OPEN each way. Watch for lane shift and crossovers. Be alert for construction equipment as bridge construction is taking place within the interchange area.
