Beloit Transit Resuming Regular Service on June 8

June 3, 2020 - Beloit Transit System is resuming its fixed route schedule in the City of Beloit on Monday, June 8.

- Monday-Friday routes are from 6 a.m. to 6:40 p.m.
- Saturday routes are from 8:40 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Beloit Transit will have safety measures in place in an attempt to continue to slow the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

- Passengers will board the bus using the rear door, except for those with mobility devices that require the aid of a ramp.
- Face coverings are highly recommended while on the bus.
- A maximum of 10 passengers per bus will be allowed to practice social distancing. Some seating will be closed off for social distancing.
- Fares will be deposited into a box on the bus to limit contact with our drivers. Tokens or cash are encouraged instead of the pass cards; please use exact change as drivers will not make change.
- The downtown Transfer Center will remain open with signage posted encouraging social distancing while waiting for buses.
- Our buses will be rotated, at a minimum, once a day for sanitization purposes. The sanitization of buses will not disrupt service.

Beloit Transit has been operating as an on-demand service since March 2020 due to COVID-19. All rides have been accommodated throughout the entirety of the on-demand service.

The Beloit-Janesville Express continued to run as regularly schedule. The BJE route runs from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m. Monday-Friday.
