Beloit Farmers' Market Expands

The Beloit Farmers' Market will will be open from 9 am to 12 pm every Saturday from June - October, rain or shine. After reviewing the safety plan and the first two weeks of operations, the City of Beloit Emergency Operations Center made the determination to increase the capacity at the Beloit Farmers' Market to 300 guests, 47 vendors, and to allow vendors on both sides of the street.

I-39/90 Expansion Project

Early next week, crews will set massive girders for the I-43 southbound flyover ramp to I-39/90 southbound. To accommodate those operations, I-43/WIS 81 northbound will be CLOSED over I-39/90 (between the interchange ramps) from 4 a.m. to 12 p.m. Monday (June 29th) and Wednesday (July 1st). Follow the signed detour route.
