Voters in wards 1-9, who usually vote at Converse, Gaston, and Hackett Schools, will join voters in wards 10-12 and vote at the **Beloit Historical Society**, **845 Hackett Street**, **Beloit**, **WI 53511** for this election only.

Voters in wards 13-22, who usually vote at the Beloit Public Library, First Congregational Church, Todd School, and River of Life UMC, will join voters in wards 23-25 and vote at Central Christian Church, 2460 Milwaukee Road, Beloit, WI 53511 for this election only.

The City Council combined polling places due to the low expected voter turn-out for this primary election, which includes the Rock County Clerk election.

Absentee Voting Information

In-person absentee voting will run from 8am to 5pm July 27 to Aug. 7 at City Hall, 100 State St., Beloit, in the first floor forum. Individuals can register to vote during this time. Physical distancing will be required and frequent sanitization will take place. Voters are highly encouraged to wear a mask.

- Deadline for absentee ballots to be in the clerk's office: 8 p.m. Aug. 11 (this does not mean postmarked or in the mail it means in the clerk's office)
