How to Vote Absentee

Registered Wisconsin voters may request an absentee ballot at [MyVote Wisconsin](https://www.myvote.wisconsin.gov). Through that website, you can also view what's on the ballot, update your name or address, find your polling place and more.

The first wave of ballots were mailed out late this week and if you requested one, it should arrive Saturday or Monday. Residents can return their ballot via US Postal Service or by depositing it in one of the newly installed, secure drop boxes at City Hall (one on the circular drive off of State Street and one inside the main entrance to City Hall).
