**City of Beloit Combines Polling Places for Spring Primary Election**

**Feb. 4, 2021** - The City Council has combined polling places for the Spring Primary Election to be held on Feb. 16, 2021, in the City of Beloit. The following polling place locations will be used for the wards indicated:

Wards 1 - 12	Beloit Historical Society	845 Hackett Street
Wards 13 - 25	Central Christian Church	2460 Milwaukee Road

Voters in wards 1-9, who usually vote at Converse, Gaston, and Hackett Schools, will join voters in wards 10-12 and vote at the **Beloit Historical Society, 845 Hackett Street, Beloit, WI 53511** for this election only.

Voters in wards 13-22, who usually vote at the Beloit Public Library, First Congregational Church, Todd School, and River of Life UMC, will join voters in wards 23-25 and vote at **Central Christian Church, 2460 Milwaukee Road, Beloit, WI 53511** for this election only.

The City Council combined polling places due to the low expected voter turn-out for this spring primary election, which includes a primary for State Superintendent of Instruction.

The deadline to request an absentee ballot by mail is 5 p.m. Thursday, February 11. In person absentee voting is currently available at City Hall from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays until Friday, February 12. After entering City Hall, use the phone in the lobby to call the Clerk/Treasurer's Office and someone will assist you with in-person absentee ballots.

If you need to return a witnessed absentee ballot, there is a secure dropbox outside of City Hall located in the circle drive off of State Street. Additionally, there is a dropbox inside the main doors at City Hall.
