Yard Waste Pickup in April

Yard waste curbside collection will take place on your regular trash day April 5 - 8 and April 12 - 15.

- Brush and shrubbery must be bundled or tied.
- Paper yard waste bags, trash containers 39 gallons or less weighing less than 60 lbs. Plastic bags not permitted.
- Yard waste must be clean and litter free.
- Yard waste sticker must be attached to each bundle or container, then placed at least 3-ft. away from your regular trash.
- \$10 for a sheet of 5 stickers. Available for purchase at Walgreens, ACE Hardware, and Woodman's.
- Stickers available for purchase by credit/debit card over the phone by calling the Clerk-Treasurer's office at 608-364-6663 or Public Works at 608-364-2929. Upon completion of purchase, yard waste stickers will be mailed.




COVID-19 Community Testing - Extended!

Face Coverings Required in City of Beloit

Face coverings are required in public places in the City of Beloit until further notice regardless of any changes at the county or state level.

The Beloit City Council approved a resolution on Monday, Nov. 16, 2020, to ensure that physical distancing and protective measures remain in place to minimize the spread of COVID-19 in Beloit, as well as requiring face coverings in public spaces in the City of Beloit.

The resolution is in effect until further notice. It will take City Council action to rescind the requirements when the City Council determines the threat of COVID-19 has subsided.
