City Council Ends Social Distancing, City-Wide Face Covering Requirements

The Beloit City Council removed its social distancing and face covering requirements based on updated guidance from the Centers for Disease Control.

At this time, face coverings are still required inside city-owned facilities and may be required at other city-sponsored activities. Private businesses may also impose face covering requirements.

Face Coverings Optional at Beloit Farmers' Market

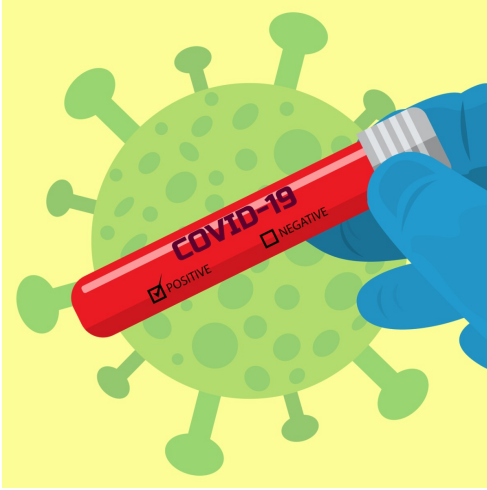
