Hot dogs, chips and water will be provided

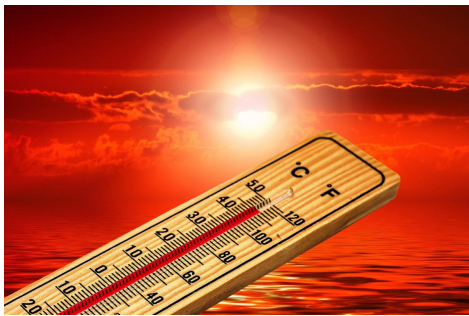
The events will be held:

Face coverings are still required at the Beloit Public Library.

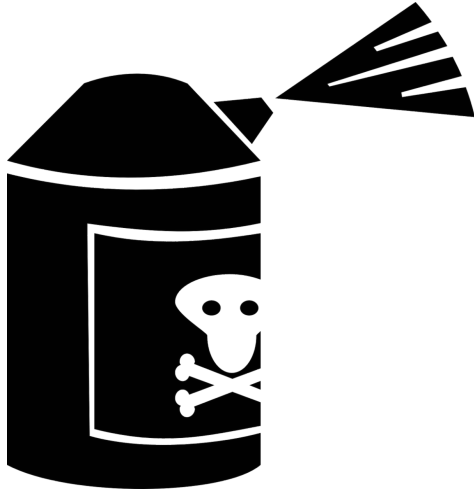
Krueger Pool Opens June 12, 2021

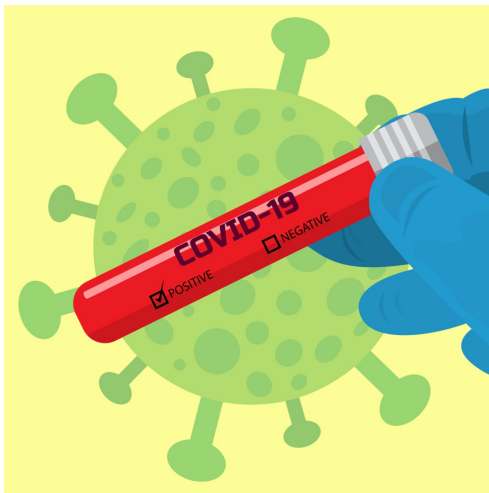
