

Traffic Alert - I-39/90 and I-43

From the Wisconsin DOT -Short-Term Ramp Closure:

- The I-43/WIS 81 ramp to I-39/90 northbound is now CLOSED until Friday, July 30.
- Drivers must use alternate routes, such



as I-43 to Hart Road then Shopiere Road to the northbound Interstate.

- Crews will pave concrete connections for the new configuration of WIS 81 through the Diverging Diamond Interchange.
- On Friday, July 30, I-43 southbound traffic will be shifted to the new WIS 81 Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) pavement. This temporary configuration will allow I-43 southbound motorists to access I-39/90 southbound or the city of Beloit. At this time, I-43 southbound motorists will also be able to use the new WIS 81 interchange ramp to I-39/90 northbound.
- I-43 northbound motorists will continue to use the detour route to reach I-39/90 northbound.
