Joint Policy Board & Technical Advisory Committee Meetings Stateline Area Transportation Study Monday June 21, 2021 at 10:00 A.M via GoToMeeting

A joint meeting of the Stateline Area Transportation Study Technical Advisory Committee and Policy Board was held on Monday June 21, 2021 via GoToMeeting. Nee called the meeting to order at 10:04 a.m

1. Call to Order and Roll Call

2. Public Participation

Carl Lange inquired about the timing of the Henry Avenue and Park Avenue projects. Dupuis noted Henry Avenue is in design from Riverside to Royce. Park Avenue south of Broad scheduled for City Council review in Beloit and South Beloit in July.

3. Approval of the Minutes of the March 29, 2021 Joint Policy Board and Technical Advisory Committee Meetings

4. Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Administrative Modifications

Dupuis noted a number of TIP Administrative Modifications in which no formal action was required including:

• IL-20-004, Illinois 2/Illinois 75 Prairie Hill Road to State Line moved from Advanced Construction to current.

- 2-13-002, South Beloit, Interim path from Bailey St. to Roscoe Avenue (formerly referred to as City Center Stateline Bicycle Link) moved to Advanced Construction. June letting anticipated.
- 2-22(-24)-001, SMTD Transit Operations, funding updates.
- 2-20-002, SMTD 3 Expansion Vehicles, moved to FY22.
- 2-20-003, SMTD CARES Act funding updates
- 291-21-009, Quick Reference Number update
- ILLUS, City of Beloit, Colley Road From Willowbrook to Gateway reconstruct and Willowbrook Road from state line to Milwaukee Road reconstruct, updated funding request for a portion of the entire project titled "Willowbrook Road Widening from Wisconsin/Illinois State Line Road to Colley Road"
- ILLUS, City of South Beloit Willowbrook Road Reconstruction (between State Line and Prairie Hill Road) added.
- ILLUS, SMTD Administration Facility added.

5. Resolution 2021-5, Adoption of Public Transit Agency Safety Plan (PTASP) Performance Measure Targets (BTS)

Dupuis reported that BTS developed a Public Transit Agency Safety Plan (PTASP) and annual safety performance targets for 2021 (see table below). SLATS must also annually adopt them and incorporate them into the TIP is July 20, 2021.

- 2. State Line Road from Manchester to E of Willow Brook Rd. Local Road to Minor Arterial
- 3. IL-75 from 1-90 NB Ramps to Wisconsin State Line. Other Arterial to Minor Arterial

Jim Meyer with AECOM provided an update on the LRTP, including project schedule, project evaluation matrix, potential projects for modelling to determine potential benefits or impacts and the second public outreach survey. Pennington commented on the benefits of the potential Milwaukee Road improvements from Leeson Park to White Avenue. No additional comments received on potential projects.

9. Scheduling of Future Meetings of the Policy Board and Technical Committees

Nee noted the next meeting would likely be August 23, 2021. Diduch/Nee reported Rockton was recently awarded an ITEP grant of nearly \$800,000 for the Old River Road Path.
