Traffic Alert

Sections of I-39/90 and I-43 near the Beloit interchange will be CLOSED and detoured:

- Monday, August 23 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.
- Motorists must follow the signed detour routes during the overnight closures:
 - I-39/90 traffic will use the interchange ramps to bypass the closure
 - I-43 and WIS 81 traffic should follow the message boards.
- Crews will remove the old WIS 81 structures over I-39/90.
- Ford Street is CLOSED at WIS81/Milwaukee Road until Labor Day weekend.
 - Drivers must use the Branigan Road intersection to access Ford Street and the local businesses.
