## MEETING MINUTES BELOIT LANDMARKS COMMISSION Tuesday, November 17, 2020, 7:00 PM The City Hall Forum, 100 State Street Beloit, WI 53511

### 1. Roll Call

Chairperson Beckman called the meeting to order at 7:04 PM. Commissioners Gallagher, Blazer, Bebow-Reinhard, McDaniel, were available by phone. Councilor Blakeley was absent.

The commission had a question about the size of the window on the south side of the residence. They suggested keeping the height in line with the existing windows on the home and if the applicant would be open to changing the design? Mr. Cepeda was agreeable to changing the design of the window. Conditions of approval were amended to include the size of window be the same length as the existing windows. Councilor Blazer moved to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness. Councilor Blakeley seconded the motion. The motion passed, voice vote.
