City Council Workshop - Sept. 27th

The City of Beloit has been allocated approximately \$15.2 million from the U.S. Treasury as part of the American Rescue Plan Act's Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (ARPA).

The Beloit City Council will host a workshop on Monday, September 27th in the City Hall Forum. The purpose of the workshop is to discuss and receive public input on ARPA funding. There will be opportunity for public input.

Social distancing and face coverings are required of all in attendance and space will be limited.

This workshop will be televised on Charter Cable Access digital channel 992 and live streamed via the Beloit Access Television (BATV) YouTube Channel.

The intersection of 8th Street and Euclid Avenue will be closed to through traffic on Monday, September 27 and Tuesday, September 28th for a watermain connection. The intersection should be re-opened by 7:00 a.m. on Wednesday, Sept. 29th. A detour route will not be posted.



I-39/90 and I-43/WIS 81 Construction Updates

From the I-39/90 Project Communications Manager:

- Nightly lane closures on I-39/90 northbound and southbound between County S/Shopiere Road and the Rest Area in Beloit.
 - 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday and Tuesday nights (Sept. 27 - 28)
 - Plan ahead and watch for

slowdowns in this area.

- I-43/WIS 80 ramp CLOSED to I-39/90 southbound in Beloit
 - 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Tuesday night (Sept. 28)
 - Alternate routes are required, such as I-39/90 northbound to County S/Shopiere Road interchange to turn around and travel south on I-39/90.
 - Crews will place permanent pavement markings on the ramp and along I-39/90 southbound.

Minor Changes Proposed to Fixed Route Transit Service

The City of Beloit Transit System (BTS) completed development of a Transit Development Plan in 2020, resulting in major route changes to Beloit's public transit bus route system. Since implementation of the new routes, BTS has identified areas needing improvements in order to alleviate timing issues and provide better connectivity to the Beloit community.
