### I-39/90 Expansion Project

From the I-39/90 Project Communications Manager:

Nightly lane closures on I-39/90 northbound and southbound near the Beloit interchange:

- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. Monday through Thursday nights (November 1 4)
- Plan ahead for slowdowns in this area

The new I-43 southbound ramp to I-39/90 northbound is now open in Beloit.

- I-43 southbound traffic wishing to enter Beloit or access I-39/90 southbound must exit at County X/Hart Road (Exit 2). Temporary detour routes:
  - Access to Beloit via Gateway Blvd. and Cranston Road

 Access to I-39/90 southbound via Gateway Blvd. to the IL 75 interchange.

**TRAFFIC ALERT:** Weather permitting on Friday (Nov. 5) crews plan to open two flyover ramps at the Beloit interchange.

- I-43 southbound ramp to I-39/90 southbound AND I-39/90 southbound ramp to I-43 northbound. Pay attention to the signs and watch for new traffic patterns.
- Download the I/39/90 and I-43 interchange navigation map for the permanent configuration starting by late November.
