I-39/90 Expansion Project

From the I-39/90 Project Communications Manager:

Exciting news to share about the I-39/90 Expansion Project between Beloit and Madison! All lanes are **OPEN** on I-39/90 northbound for 45 miles from the Illinois state line to Madison. Please continue to follow the reduced speed limit of 60 mph in the work zones. Four lanes are **OPEN** on I-39/90 southbound through Janesville, and three lanes on I-39/90 southbound in Madison and Beloit anticipated to open in mid-November.

Weather-permitting on Wednesday (Nov. 10), the I-43 southbound flyover ramp to I-39/90 southbound will **OPEN**.

- In the meantime, I-43 southbound traffic wishing to enter Beloit or access I-39/90 southbound must exit at County X/Hart Road (Exit 2). Temporary detour routes:
 - Access to Beloit via Gateway Blvd. and Cranston Road.
 - Access to I-39/90 southbound via Gateway Blvd. to the IL 75 interchange.
- Pay attention to the signs and watch for new traffic patterns!
- The I-39/90 southbound flyover ramp to I-43 northbound and I-39/90 northbound ramp to I-43 northbound are expected to open by mid-November.
- Download the I-39/90 and I-43

<u>interchange navigation map</u> for the permanent configuration starting by late November.

New Beloit COVID-19 Testing Location

The Rock County Public Health Department will host a COVID-19 RT-PCR testing site at its Beloit location at 61 Eclipse Avenue in partnership with Summit Clinical Laboratories beginning November 8, 2021.

Walk-in and by-appointment testing will be available Monday - Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Testing will be available for all ages, including newborns. Patients should bring along ID and, if insured, insurance or Medicare cards. COVID-19 testing will be provided at no out-of-pocket cost to anyone who is having symptoms or thinks they have been exposed.

For faster service, clients wishing to test at the new RCPHD-Summit Labs Beloit testing site may pre-register with the Wisconsin Department of Health Services COVID Connect website at register.covidconnect.wi.gov.
