

Rock County is working to ensure everyone has access to quality internet connectivity. The county has asked us to share this speed test link with our community: http://madisonregion.org/industry-andinnovation/broadband/

Internet speeds that fall below the FCC standards are eligible for federal and state grants. To improve internet connectivity

throughout the county, the Rock County Ad Hoc Broadband Committee will use this speed test data to work with Internet Service Providers to identify, as well as prioritize, future broadband-related investments.
