City of Beloit Removes Face Covering Requirement for Members of the Public in City Buildings

Residents urged to continue following CDC's guidance, receive COVID-19 vaccine.

February 28, 2022 - Members of the public are no longer required to wear face coverings while inside of City of Beloit facilities, effective March 1, 2022.

This change comes after reviewing the updated guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Rock County Health Department as it relates to COVID-19 prevention measures. Individuals who rent city facilities for private use will not be required to wear face coverings either.

Employees and contractors/vendors are required to continue wearing face coverings indoors at this time. The City of Beloit wants to ensure there are no unintended consequences in our community prior to further changing our workplace safety policies. Any future changes will be clearly communicated in the coming weeks.
