City Attorney, Elizabeth Krueger, Appointed Interim City Manager

June 21, 2022 - The Beloit City Council appointed City Attorney/Deputy City Manager Elizabeth Krueger as Interim City Manager on June 20, 2022, effective August 5, 2022 upon the departure of City Manager Lori Curtis Luther.

Krueger was hired by the City of Beloit on May 9, 2006. She has served as the City Attorney since 2014 and as Deputy City Manager since 2015. Krueger began supervising the Human Resources Department in 2018, enhancing the inclusiveness of the city's recruiting and hiring practices. In addition to her municipal legal expertise, Krueger has a breadth of knowledge that spans all operational areas of the city government, which include but are not limited to, police, fire, public works, planning and development, economic development, finance, information technology, and human resources.

"City Attorney Krueger will bring stability and continuity while we initiate the search for the next city manager," said City Council President Regina Dunkin. "The process will involve public participation and opportunities for community input. The first step will be the selection of a professional recruitment firm to assist the City Council."

Krueger has had a direct impact on all city-related projects and has served as acting city manager as needed.

"I implicitly trust City Attorney Krueger to protect the interests of the organization and the community at large," said City Manager Lori Curtis Luther.

Krueger has lived in the Beloit area for 16 years and is intimately familiar with this community and is deeply invested in its success.

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
