City of Beloit Combines Polling Places for August Primary Election

July 6, 2022 - The City Council has combined polling places for the primary election to be held on Aug. 9, 2022, in the City of Beloit. The following polling places will be used for the wards indicated:

Wards 1-11; 24- 26	Beloit Historical Society	845 Hackett Street
Wards 12-23; 27- 30	Central Christian Church	2460 Milwaukee Road

Voters in wards 1-6 and 24-26, who live on the west side of the Rock River will vote at the **Beloit Historical Society**, **845 Hackett Street**, **Beloit**, **WI 53511** for the August election only.

Voters in wards 12-20 and 27, who live on the east side of the Rock River will join voters in wards 21-23 and 28-30 to vote at **Central Christian Church**, 2460 Milwaukee Road, **Beloit**, WI 53511 for the August election only.

The City Council combined polling places due to the low expected voter turn-out for this primary election.

Please confirm your ward number at myvote.wi.gov as ward numbers and regular polling locations may have changed due to redistricting.

Important Deadlines and Absentee Voting Information

In-person absentee voting will be available from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays Tuesday, July 26, to Thursday, August 4, and from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. Friday, August 5, 2022. Absentee voting will take place on the 2^{nd} floor of Beloit City Hall in the City Clerk-Treasurer's Office.

Additionally, individuals can register to vote and cast an absentee ballot by mail. Please check out these important deadlines:

- Deadline to register by mail or online: July 20
- Deadline to register at City Hall: 5 p.m. Aug. 5 (you can still register at the polls)
- Deadline to request an absentee ballot: 5 p.m. Aug. 4
- Deadline for absentee ballots to be in the clerk's office: 8 p.m. Aug. 9 (this does not mean postmarked or in the mail it means in the clerk's office)

If you received a ballot via the mail, you must return the witness ballot via the U.S. Postal Service or directly to the City Clerk-Treasurer's Office on the second floor at City Hall. DO NOT PLACE THE BALLOT IN ANY CITY HALL DROPBOXES AS THE BALLOT MAY NOT BE COUNTED.
