

WI DNR Awards City of Beloit 600K for Private Lead Line Replacement

The Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources has awarded the City of Beloit \$600,000 in grant funding to create a program for residents to replace their private lead service water lines. This grant is provided through the DNR's Safe Drinking Water Loan Program.

The grant will fund the replacement of private lead service lines that result in a total line replacement. The grant can only be used for the customer portion of the service line. Learn More

Spring Election Update

The clerk-treasurer's office has mailed the first batch of absentee ballots to individuals who requested the ballots for April 5, 2022, election by mail. Ballots should be returned using the United States Postal Service or inperson at City Hall between 8 am and 5 pm Mondays-Fridays. Ballots must be received by 8 pm April 5, 2022, to be counted.

Do not place absentee ballots in either utility bill dropbox. Ballots placed in the drop boxes may not be counted.

Still need to register to vote? You can register in person at City Hall or at your polling place on Election Day. Visit <u>My Vote</u> to find your polling place; your polling place may have changed due to redistricting.
