

WALMART BUS STOP TEMPORARILY CLOSING



Walmart Bus Stop to Temporarily Close

The parking lot at Walmart is scheduled to have improvements done beginning Monday, June 13, 2022, until, tentatively, June 23, 2022. Due to these parking lot improvements, Beloit Transit will be required to temporarily close the bus stop at the front of the store.

Due to the bus stop being closed, alternate bus stops will have to be used. The bus stop on Branigan Rd next to McDonald's will be an alternative bus stop to be used before the bus continues on its way to Piggly Wiggly. The stop on Cranston Rd next to First National Bank is the alternate bus stop to be used after Piggly Wiggly and before Walmart as the bus heads downtown to Transfer Center. We will work with the pavement crew to get the bus stop opened up as soon as possible so we can return to normal routing.
