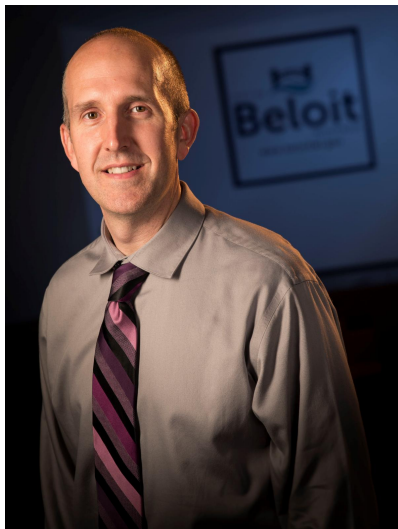


Beloit City Council Meeting - Monday, July 18, 2022
