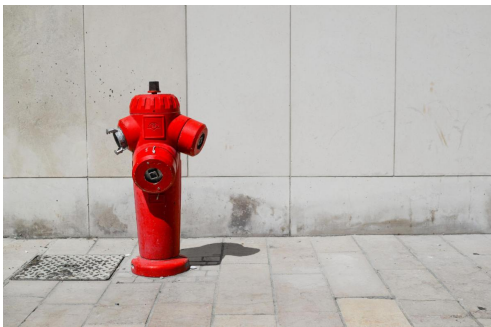


Beloit City Council Meeting - Monday, August 1, 2022

Hydrant Flushing Program Begins August 1

The City of Beloit Public Works' Water Resources Division will perform its annual fire hydrant flushing program from August 1, 2022, through November 30, 2022, during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Mondays through Fridays.

This flushing program ensures that the fire hydrants are in good working condition in case of emergencies and helps flush sediment out of the distribution system.

Residents may experience discolored water, low water pressure, or a disruption of service during this time period. Residents are urged to reduce water use and consumption during this time period and wait to do laundry until AFTER 3 p.m. when crews are in the area during the flushing program.
