

Project Purpose & Goals

- Why is this study taking place?
 - IL 75 is a vital east-west arterial that connects South Beloit to I-39/90 freeway
 - Significant truck traffic uses IL 75 for local and regional travel
 - Increased initiative to revitalize areas along IL 75
 - Planned and proposed development along and near IL 75 will likely require roadway / intersection improvements
 - Existing corridor is a barrier for bicyclists and pedestrians








Project Purpose & Goals

- What this study is / will do
 - Evaluation of traffic operations, traffic safety, access, and multimodal accommodations for IL 75 (Gardner Street) corridor
 - Recommend improvements to the roadway and intersections to optimize safety and mobility while balancing access and multimodal needs
- What this study is not / will not do
 - Construction project to repair existing roadway pavement

There is no construction project associated with the results and recommendations determined in this study.

- Traffic operations
 - Optimize traffic flow for all vehicles
 - Improve traffic movement at traffic signals





- Traffic safety
 - 155 traffic crashes (2017 May 2022)
 - 0 fatal crashes, 5 A-injury crashes, 17
 B-injury crashes, 14 C-injury crashes
 - Crash frequency
 - US 51 intersection 33 crashes
 - Blackhawk intersection 28 crashes
 - Willowbrook intersection 21 crashes
 - Crash type
 - Turning
 - Rear end
 - Angle











Access

- High access density from Blackhawk to Park
- Low access density from US
 51 to the east
- Numerous vacant access driveways







- Multimodal accommodations
 - Barrier to north-south travel
 - Missing equipment & markings
