Grinnell Hall Senior Center Announces Veteran Day Ceremony

October 24, 2022 - Grinnell Hall Senior Center will be hosting a Veteran's Day Ceremony on Friday, November 11 at 10:00am inside Grinnell Hall. The public is invited and light refreshments will be served following the ceremony.

Grinnell Hall has a history in serving Veterans and their families. In April of 1936 Emma H. Grinnell willed \$100,000 to build a Memorial Hall for patriotic organizations in loving memory of her husband, William H. Grinnell. William served in the Wisconsin Volunteer infantry during the Civil War. In 1977 the Veteran organizations connected with the City of Beloit and Grinnell Hall became the property of the City of Beloit. Veteran organization leaders and city staff work together to meet the needs of the veterans and seniors. Grinnell Hall has a Veteran's Room which has a Honor Wall and a beautiful Veteran Mural created by artist Lynn Reynolds. We welcome you to visit when you are here.

The Ceremony will include Posting of Color by Junior ROTC members from Beloit Memorial High School, Patriotic Songs by Goldenaires Choir, presentations by David Wood, retired US Navy Vietnam Combat Veteran and Kevin Manhart, retired United States Air Force Master Sergeant, Prayer for Veterans by Pastor Steven Erkel from United Church of Beloit and Taps played by Jon Condon.
