In-person Absentee Voting Continues until November 4, 2022

In-person absentee voting begins at 8:30 am until 4 pm weekdays starting on October 25 through November 4 (extended hours to 5 pm on November 4 only). In-person absentee voting will take place on the 1st floor at City Hall.

To ensure your vote is counted:

- Do not place ballots in City Hall drop boxes or your vote may not count; either return via U.S. Postal Service or return directly to the 2nd floor Clerk-Treasurer's Office.
- Only the voter can return the ballot to the clerk's office or place in the mail unless a voter with disabilities needs help returning their ballots.
- Make sure all fields are properly filled out, including the witness signature and address.

The free fall collection of yard waste will be October 31-November 17 on your regularly scheduled solid waste collection day. This includes contained leaves, grass clippings, and garden debris. Brush and shrubbery will be picked up with a \$2 sticker per bundle.

Don't want the hassle of bagging leaves? Rake or blow your leaves to the terrace and we will take care of the rest with the leaf vacuuming subscription. The fee is \$125 for the 2022 season.

City of Beloit Supporting Main Street Bounceback Grants

The City of Beloit is providing letters of support to local businesses seeking the State of Wisconsin's Main Street Bounceback Grant. The deadline to apply for the grant is December 31, 2022.

The program provides \$10,000 grants to businesses moving into vacant commercial spaces of at least 400 square feet. The grant funds can be used for lease or mortgage payments, operating expenses, building repairs, tenant improvements and other qualified expenses. Funds cannot be used on storage spaces or for residential uses.
