SEX OFFENDER RELEASE - COMMUNITY NOTIFICATION

Nov. 4, 2022 - Terrance O. Harvey Jr. will be released from prison on November 8 and will reside at 1216 Portland Ave., Beloit, WI, which is a temporary living placement location rented by the Wisconsin Department of Corrections. The City of Beloit Police Department is notifying the community about this placement; the City of Beloit Police Department does not make placement decisions.

Tattoos: neck-reaper, savage life; chest-woman's name, stars; left shoulder-woman's name; left arm - 15 skulls, bandana, guns, brick wall, money roll, 2 dice, shotgun with shells, 3 5-point stars with skulls; left hand - first; lower right arm - cross; right hand - family.

The purpose of this notification is to ensure safe neighborhoods by informing the public when a sex offender who qualifies for a Special Bulletin Notification is released into the Beloit community. On June 1, 1997, Wisconsin State Statute 301.45 (Act 440), the Sex Offender Registration and Community Notification Law, took effect to enhance public safety and protection.

Harvey was convicted of two counts of 3rd degree sexual assault in 2017 in Rock County Circuit Court. His victims include adult females.

Harvey remains on supervision until November 10, 2032, and is required to register with the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry. He also will be on lifetime GPS monitoring.

Conditions of supervision include:

- No unsupervised contact with minors
- No contact with the victim(s)
- Not to consume drugs
- Comply with standard sex offender rules
- Cooperate with electronic monitoring
- Face-to-face contact with law enforcement
- Comply with all requirements and lifetime registration of the Wisconsin Sex Offender Registry

The Beloit Police Department expects Harvey to cooperate and comply with the above conditions and rules. If you observe any violations, please contact the Beloit Police Department at the non-emergency number: 608-757-2244.
