In person absentee voting will be available starting Tuesday, February 7th at City Hall, 2nd Floor Clerk's office during the days and hours below:

- Tuesday, Feb. 7 - Thursday, Feb. 16 from 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- Friday, Feb. 17 - 8:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Polling places for the primary election to be held on Feb. 21, 2023 have been combined.

Voters who live on the west side of the Rock River will vote at the Beloit Historical Society, 845 Hackett Street, Beloit, WI 53511 for the February election only.

Voters who live on the east side of the Rock River will vote at Central Christian Church, 2460 Milwaukee Road, Beloit, WI 53511 for the February election only.

The City Council combined polling places due to the low expected voter turn-out for this primary election.
