Spring Cemetery Clean-Up

- New decorations may be placed Monday, May 1, 2023.
- Artificial and cut flower arrangements must be placed in durable containers.
- Glass, china and fragile vases are not permitted.
- Cemetery staff will dispose of excessive or inappropriate decorations.



Spring Terrace Tree Planting

The City of Beloit Public Works Department is currently accepting requests from residents for terrace trees to be planted this spring. Trees will be planted on a first-come, first-served basis.

The terrace tree species selection will be determined by the city forestry supervisor while taking into account the size of the terrace, presence of utilities and exotic invasve insects. A limited supply of trees are available. Forestry will accept requests through Friday, April 28, 2023.

Monthly Yard Waste Curbside Collection - April 10 - 13

Yard waste must be set out by 6:00 a.m. on your regular scheduled collection date:

- Brush and shrubbery must be bundled or tied.
- Paper yard waste bags, trash containers 39 gallons or less weighing less than 60 lbs.
- Plastic bags are not permitted.
- Yard waste must be clean and litter free.
- Sticker must be attached to each bundle or container then placed at least 3 feet away from your regular trash.

Stickers are \$10 for a sheet of five. Available for purchase at Department of Public Works, ACE Hardware, Woodman's, City Hall Clerk-Treasurer, and Grinnell Hall.
