PUBLIC INPUT/INFORMATION SESSIONS – MICROTRANSIT STUDY May 1, 2023

April 28, 2023 – Stateline Area Transportation Study (SLATS) and Beloit Transit Services (BTS) are studying Beloit area transportation and transit services with the goal of optimizing overall transit service for the Beloit community. This study will analyze existing conditions to understand the current transportation system and determine whether microtransit can help enhance Beloit transit services. Microtransit is a demand-response transportation option for short, local trips, using smaller vehicles than traditional buses.

The public is invited to an in-person information session to share feedback on transit in Beloit and to learn more about microtransit. There will be two sessions on Monday, May 1, 2023:

Morning Session: 7:00 – 9:00 a.m. at the Beloit Transfer Facility, 225 Shirland Ave.

Staff will be on-site to answer questions and hear feedback

Afternoon Session: 4:00 – 6:00 p.m. at the Beloit Public Library, 605 Eclipse Blvd.
