The United Veterans Memorial Day Parade Committee members have been hard at work planning this years parade. It will be held on Memorial Day, May 29th and proceed from South Beloit into Beloit.

The route will start on Blackhawk Blvd., proceeding north into Beloit on State Street, turning east on E. Grand and ending at Horace White Park. Bushnell Street will be closed to traffic near Horace White Park for bus parking. The City of Beloit is partnering with South Beloit for enhanced safety and security along the parade route.

City of Beloit offices will be closed on Monday, May 29th; police and fire will work as usual and public works will be available to respond to emergencies.


