


### Beloit Celebrates Public Works Week




## Beloit Public Library Summer Program Guide

## Rock County Impaired Driving Enforcement

Law enforcement officers from several Rock County agencies will be looking to prevent impaired driving. Rock County Impaired Driving Enforcement Task Force is deploying on the following days:

- May 19, 2023
- May 27, 2023

During this additional enforcement, the participating agencies will have more officers on

patrol to discourage people from driving while impaired. There will be zero tolerance for driving under the influence, open intoxicants, seatbelt violations and improper use of child safety restraints.

The goal of this high-visibility enforcement is to encourage drivers to make an alternative plan so they don't drive while drunk or high.


