Public Information Meetings on Upcoming Road Projects

The community is invited to join the Department of Public Works' Engineering Division for two public informational meetings on upcoming road projects. Both meetings will be held at 2400 Springbrook Court.

- Tuesday, July 18, 5:30-6:30 p.m. -Topic: Cranston Road between Prairie Avenue and Collingswood Drive.
- Wednesday, July 19, 5:30 6:30 p.m. -Topic: Henry Avenue between Royce Avenue and Prairie Avenue.

Both projects are scheduled for construction in 2024. Each project includes street resurfacing and a road diet that converts four lane sections of roadway to two lanes. These projects are planned with traffic-calming measures



designed to reduce speed and life-threatening accidents.

The event will take place on Wednesday, July 19, 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. at the Vernon Park Splash Pad, 934 Vernon Avenue.




Job Fair at Beloit Public Library

The City of Beloit released its 2022 Popular Annual Financial Report (PAFR). The PAFR is designed to extract information about the city's operating budget from the Annual Comprehensive Financial Report in a format that is readily accessible and easily understood by those who do not have a background in public finance.

The City of Beloit first introduced the PAFR with the 2018 financial year and has received an award for Outstanding Achievement in Popular Annual Financial Reporting from the Government Finance Officers Association for 2018 - 2021.
