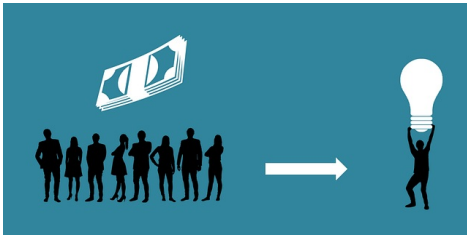

The City of Beloit has been selected as a member of the International City/County Management Association (ICMA)'s Economic Mobility and Opportunity Cohort. As a member of the cohort, the City of Beloit will receive a \$30,000 grant to advance local activities designed to boost upward mobility for our residents.
