Free NARCAN® Vending Machine Now Available at Beloit Public Library

Thanks to the collaboration of several agencies and a \$50,000 grant from the state's Opioid Settlement Funds, Beloit now has access to free NARCAN® and fentanyl test strips via a vending machine located at Beloit Public Library.

This is Rock County's second such machine; the first was installed at the Rock County Jail in December of 2022.

The vending machine will be accessible any time the library is open: 9:30 a.m. - 9:00 p.m. Monday - Thursday and 9:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. Friday through Saturday. On weekdays, the front doors are unlocked at 7:00 a.m. to provide access to the bathrooms, Blender Cafe, and gallery where the vending machine will be located.


# Rock County Impaired Driving Enforcement Task Force


