Youth Recreation Programming - Seeking Community Input

The City of Beloit is looking to fund \$250,000 in grants to local non-profits through the American Rescue Plan Act. We have held several public sessions this year on this topic and our last opportunity to provide input is at 6 pm **Tuesday, September 12**, at Merrill Community Center, 1428 Wisconsin Ave., Beloit, with the Park, Recreation and Conservation Advisory Committee (PRCAC).

We are looking for the community to share what the needs are for non-profit youth programming and how the funding should be prioritized. Previous feedback has included serving a diverse population, providing transportation, and offsetting the cost of programming, among many other suggestions.

PRCAC will meet again on September 13th to recommend priorities and make suggestions on the applications and scoring rubric before the program application process is sent to the Beloit City Council for approval.
