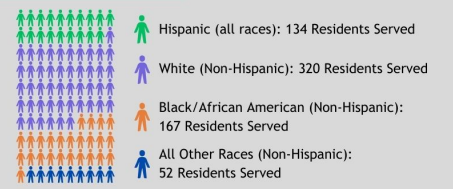
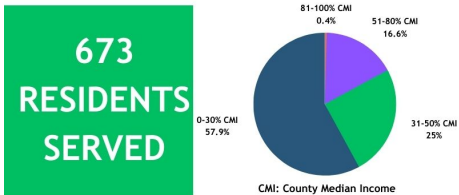

Beloit Report

INVESTING IN COMMUNITY

The Beloit City Council provided \$950,000 of American Rescue Plan Act funding as grants to non-profit organizations providing homelessness prevention and response services to Beloit residents. Data provided by service agencies with the number of people served from June-September 2023.



- 361 residents served in a household with children under age 18.
- 216 residents served in a household with an elderly (62+) person.
- 28 residents served with a female as the head of household.
- 11 residents served in a household with a handicapped or disabled person.
- 28 residents served in a household with a single parent.



Access to Service

- 300 people served now have new or continuing access to this service or benefit.
- 335 people served now have improved access to this service or benefit.

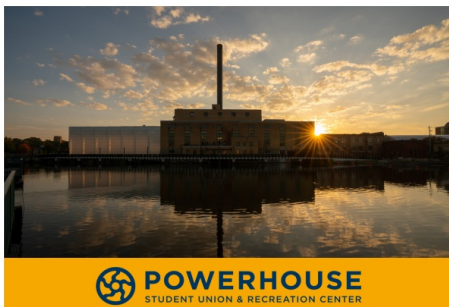
34 people were provided with overnight shelter.



Investing in Community

Earlier this year, the Beloit City Council provided \$950,000 of American Rescue Plan Act funding (over a three-year period) as grants to non-profit organizations providing homelessness prevention and response services to Beloit residents. In the first four months of the program, 673 residents have been served in our community through these grants.

Leaf Vacuum Subscription Service

Leaf Vacuum Subscription Service costs \$125 annual fee and will take place from:

- **October 30 - November 17**

Leaves will be vacuumed multiple times during the service period. A schedule will be provided to subscribers. All leaves must be raked or blown to the terrace. Leaves cannot be contained in cans or bags.

The City of Beloit is not responsible for the timeliness in which leaves fall from the trees or weather-related cancellation of the leaf vacuum service. No refunds will be issued. This service is only available in the fall.
