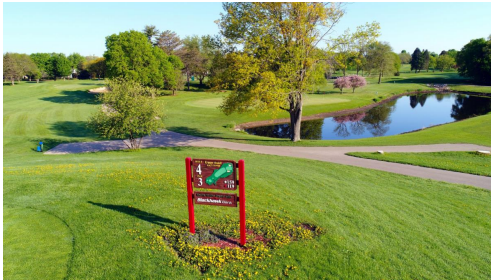
Youth Panel on Homelessness Event

A quorum of EOC members may be present; no official business will take place.

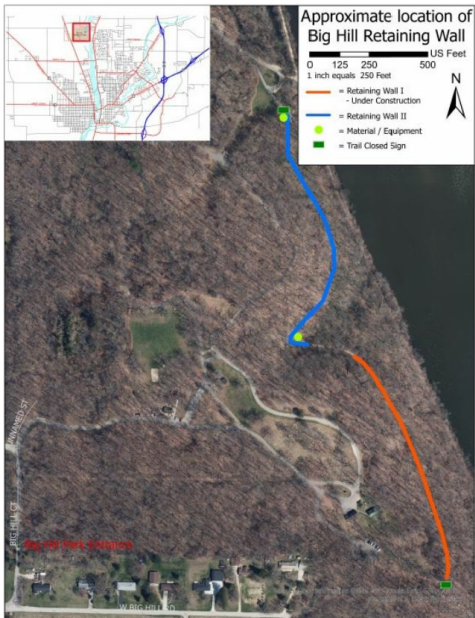


Krueger Haskell Golf Course Twilight Golf

Big Hill Park Retaining Wall

If you hike at Big Hill Park, you may have noticed construction activity on the "Model T" hiking trail that runs along the east side of the park, close to the river. The entire hiking trail is marked as closed to keep pedestrians off the trail for their safety, and prevent visitors from having to turn back on the trail. Project completion is set for December 31, weather dependent.

As of October 30th, approximately 330 feet of the retaining wall has been removed. While the stone is mostly in good shape, some of the stone on the bottom course is crumbling and needs replacing. The contractor is taking down and rebuilding a portion of the wall at a time.

I to the south (Orange) is being contracted for repair. The entire trail is marked as closed to keep pedestrians off the trail for their safety and prevent visitors from having to turn back on the trail.

Project completion is set for December 31st, weather dependent.



Free Fall Curbside Yard Waste Collection

Free Fall Curbside Yard Waste Collection will take place:

There is no limit of the amount of bagged or barreled leaves, grass clippings and garden

debris that may be placed for pick-up curbside. All other items such as brush, shrubbery, logs, etc. require a yard waste sticker.

Leaf Vacuum Subscription Service

Leaf Vacuum Subscription Service costs \$125 annual fee and will take place from:

- **October 30 - November 17**

Leaves will be vacuumed multiple times during the service period. A schedule will be provided to subscribers. All leaves must be raked or blown to the terrace. Leaves cannot be contained in cans or bags.

The City of Beloit is not responsible for the timeliness in which leaves fall from the trees or weather-related cancellation of the leaf vacuum service. No refunds will be issued. This service is only available in the fall.
