

- Solid Waste Collection: Garbage and recycling collection will be delayed by one day for those who have Thursday solid waste collection. Pickup will be on Friday, Nov. 24.
- **Recycling Drop-Off Center:** The Recycling Drop-Off Center is closed on Saturday, Nov. 25.
- Beloit Public Library: The library will close early at 5:30 p.m. Wednesday, Nov. 22, for the holiday. It will be closed on Thanksgiving and reopen on Friday, Nov. 24.

Beloit Transit Joining WisGo

Beloit Transit will launch WisGo in spring 2024, an account-based fare payment system powered by Umo Mobility (a division of the Cubic Corporation). Riders will have a unified way to pay fare, plan a trip and track transportation options. Once the system is in place, riders will still have the option to pay in cash; the advantage to using the Umo mobile app will include automatic deduction for correct fare amount, trip planning and recording, bus history usage, and ease of paying a fare.
