This pilot program will address the growing need for specialized assistance during mental health crises and aims to provide immediate support, ensure follow-up care, and enhance the department's ability to handle sensitive calls for service.

Tax Bills in the Mail

Tax bills are in the mail, and we remind the community that all payments are made to the Rock County Treasurer's Office. Please be sure to take a look at the Tax Bill Newsletter that was included with the bill. It contains a good explanation about the 2024 revaluation that will be conducted next year. The revaluation will be for tax bills that will be mailed in December 2024 and payable in 2025.

The total tax rate will vary based on school district boundaries, but the city's portion of the tax bill is \$7.58 per \$1,000 of assessed value, a decrease of \$.14 per \$1,000 of assessed value from last year.
