Protect Your Pipes This Winter

We've had a mild start to the winter, but you know the deep freeze will come (it's Wisconsin)! The City of Beloit Water Resources Division offers some tips to prevent pipes from freezing.

- Check the temperature of your water
- Prevent freezing of service lateral by keeping water moving
- Check heating components
- Be careful when thawing frozen pipes
- Check empty and vacant buildings
- Check for cold air drafts
- Make plans while traveling



- Ensure drains and other plumbing equipment are working properly
- Disconnect garden hoses and shut off the water flowing to outside spigots

Curbside collection of Christmas trees will occur **January 8 - 19, 2024**. To participate, place your tree curbside by 6 a.m. on your regular collection day.

Holiday wreaths and garland can be disposed of at the curb with your trash on your regular collection day.

PLEASE NOTE: Trees must be free of stands (including wooden stands), bags, lights, garland, tinsel, ornaments, etc.
