

#### Renew Your Dog License Now

Don't forget to renew your dog license! On January 1 of each year, you are required to license all dogs aged 5 months or over. You are required to provide proof of their current rabies vaccination, which also shows the tag numbers and the expiration dates.

The fee is \$10/spayed or neutered dog; the fee for all other dogs is \$20/dog. If the dog is licensed after April 1, there is a \$10 late fee imposed unless you are a new resident of the city or if the dog is newly acquired. Dog licenses expire December 31.

Noncompliance may result in the issuance of a citation.
