\$6M Affordable Rental Housing Creation/Preservation Fund


The City of Beloit is investing \$6 million into the creation and/or preservation of affordable rental homes in our community. The City will soon accept grant applications from housing developers seeking to create and/or preserve affordable rental homes.

A pre-application eligibility process for



developers will open from March 18 - April 1, 2024, and eligible applicants will be invited to apply for funding from April 12 - May 10, 2024. The City Council will review applications against established criteria including location, supportive services, funding diversity, plan quality, and developer qualifications.

Impaired Driving Enforcement

If you're out celebrating this weekend with green beer, make sure to designate a sober driver to take you home. Law enforcement officers from several Rock county agencies will be looking to prevent impaired driving. Rock County Impaired Driving Enforcement Task Force, including the City of Beloit Police Department, is deploying on March 16 and 17, as well as March 29.

During this additional enforcement, participating agencies will have more officers on patrol to discourage people from driving while impaired. There will be zero tolerance for driving under the influence, open intoxicants, seatbelt violations, and improper use of child safety restraints.

The goal of this high-visibility enforcement is to encourage drivers to make an alternative plan so they don't drive while drunk or high.



In Person Absentee Voting

Absentee voting will soon start for the April 2, 2024 election.

In-person absentee voting will take place at Beloit City Hall, first floor:

- March 19-22 and March 25-28, weekdays from 8:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.;
- Sunday, March 24 from 11:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m.; and
- Friday, March 29 from 1:00 5:00 p.m.

Small Business Grant Opportunity
