Summit Park Renaming

City offices will be closed on Friday, March 29 in observance of the Spring Holiday.


The Recycling Center Drop Off Center will be closed on Saturday, March 30.

Beloit Transit service is as follows for Friday, March 29:

- Route 1 and Route 2 will begin service at 7:00 a.m. with trips departing every 30 minute from the downtown Transfer Center until the last trip departs at 4:30 p.m.
- Route 3 and Route 6 will begin service from the downtown Transfer Center at 7:00 a.m. with trips departing every 60 minutes. The last trip will depart from the downtown Transfer Center at 4:00 p.m.
- Route 4 will begin service at Beloit Clinic at 7:28 a.m. with trips departing every 30 minutes from the Beloit Clinic. The last trip will depart at 4:30 p.m. and will end service at 4:38 p.m. at Piggly Wiggly.
- Beloit-Janesville Express will run regular

- service beginning at 6:00 a.m. with a bus leaving for Janesville every 60 minutes from the downtown Transfer Center. The last trip will depart at 5:00 p.m.
- There will be no Route 5 service on the holiday schedule.
- On Saturday, March 30th, we will be running our usual "On Demand" service. Anyone wishing to schedule a ride for Saturday should call and make a reservation Monday-Friday before 3:30 p.m.
