Beloit Police Announce Results of Recent Search Warrant

April 24, 2024 -- On Monday, April 22, 2024, the Violent Crime Interdiction Team (VCIT), conducted a search warrant operation, which resulted in the arrest of two individuals and the confiscation of weapons, drugs and currency.

The search warrant was served in the 1700 block of Gateway Boulevard, as follow-up to an investigation into drug offenses and violent crimes. Collectively, the operation resulted in the seizure of four firearms with one of those firearms being stolen, a quantity of cocaine, THC, MDMA and \$2,977 in cash. Some of the evidence collected in the search warrant includes:

- 1,106.77 Grams of Cocaine
- 1,038.91 Grams of THC
- 22.96 Grams of Unknown Substance
- 6.46 Grams of Unknown Substance
- 3 Firearms
- 1 Additional Stolen Firearm
- \$2,977 Cash

The following individuals were arrested at the time of the search warrant and the department is not currently seeking to make any additional arrests in this case. Additional charges may result pending further investigation and analysis of seized evidence.
