Broad Street Bridge Work - New Start Date

Due to an unforeseen delay on the contractor's part, work will begin the week of May 13th on the Broad Street bridge in downtown Beloit. One lane of traffic will be open in each direction while the work is being completed. Please use caution while driving in the area. Work is expected to continue until the last week in June.

The project will start with the northbound lanes being closed with traffic directed to the southbound lanes. Mid-way through the project, traffic will shift to the northbound side of the bridge with the southbound lanes being closed.

The project is being done to repair the bridge abutment.
